## SHOW RULES

1. Sponsors will not be held responsible for any damage to or loss of any property during the show or contest.
2. The management reserves the right to alter and combine classes as they see fit.
3. The judge shall place each class as he/she sees fit. ***In all cases the judge's decision is final.***
4. Entry fees: \$10.00/head for all species.
5. Only bona fide 4-H & FFA members are eligible to exhibit or compete.
6. Any exhibitor may enter as many exhibits as he or she wishes.
7. All exhibits must be owned, cared for, and in possession of the junior exhibitor. Proof of ownership satisfactory to show officials may be required at any time.
8. Junior contestants are those age 8-10 as of December 31 of the previous year.
9. Intermediate contestants are those age 11-13 as of December 31 of the previous year.
10. Senior contestants are those age 14-18 as of December 31 of the previous year.
11. In showmanship classes, the exhibitor ***must*** show his/her own animal.
12. Owner must be present to exhibit in classes.
13. All prospect market lambs must be shown slick shorn.
14. **NO adhesives, oils or paints will be allowed for show preparation. Clipping and blowing only.**
15. All livestock will be in good health. Any found with evidence of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases will be refused entry and must leave the grounds immediately.
16. Show management reserves the right to refuse entry into classes to any exhibitor practicing unethical management of livestock (including the use of non-labeled drugs on livestock) designed to provide the exhibitor with an unfair competitive advantage. The show management also reserves the right to refuse entry into classes to any exhibitor using unethical artificial aids on livestock designed to provide the exhibitor with an unfair competitive advantage. Remember: The "tampering or drugging of livestock" is a Class 1 misdemeanor as stated in Colorado Revised Statute 18-9-207. The K.C.C. Spring Show Management supports to the fullest, the tenants of the USDA Wholesome Meat Act.
17. The KCC Prospect Show supports the tenants of the National Show Ring Code of Ethics and reserves the right to refuse entry or participation in classes or the withholding of prizes based on violations of the code.
18. Participants please note: This Prospect Show is an optional event. Participants should also realize that you are taking a risk of disease transmittal whenever you take stock from the farm.
19. All out of state livestock will be accepted only with an Official Health certificate with Entry Permit Number signed by a licensed Veterinarian.

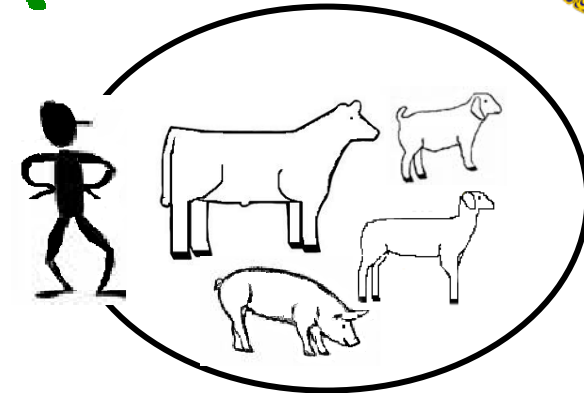
