



Complete and Include with all Soil Samples submitted for analysis

Soil samples should be taken from several spots in the area you want to have tested. Collect the samples from the soil surface to a depth of at least 8 inches. Use a clean shovel or soil probe and a clean pail, bucket or box in which to collect the sample. If multiple samples are collected that represent one area, it is best to combine them into one sample.

Allow the samples to dry on a clean table before submitting them for analysis. The sample can be placed in a plastic or paper bag. Submit no more than one pint per sample. Please remove any rocks. Only the soil will be tested.
