

2010 DELTA COUNTY 4-H INVITATIONAL SHOOT

Saturday, June 26, 2010

LOCATION: 4-H Eckert Shooting Range

REGISTRATION: Pre-registration is **required**. Registrations may be submitted to the Delta, Mesa or Montrose Extension Offices, but **must** be turned in (NOT POST-MARKED) no later than **Friday, June 18, 2010**. **Late registrations must be brought to the shoot and must include the \$5.00 late fee.**

(Relays to continue as needed)

Awards will be presented immediately following scoring.

FOOD: A food concession stand will be available all day, but there is **NO** scheduled lunch break! Competitors must plan their lunchtimes during their relays off.

FEES: \$10.00 for shotgun; \$3.00 for each additional non-shotgun event; **MAXIMUM OF FIVE EVENTS PER PARTICIPANT**. Payment **must** accompany entry form. **Make checks payable to: Delta Shooting Sports Council**. For more information, or to pay by credit card, see the registration form.

RULES: The contest will follow the State 4-H Shooting Sports Rule Books.

Contestants **must** present a valid Colorado Hunter Safety Card at the contest site, or file a waiver with the Delta Extension Office prior to the shoot. All participants are expected to know and obey all standard NRA range rules and commands. All equipment is subject to inspection by range officers for safety of function.

EQUIPMENT: Each contestant must provide his or her own firearms. Bring a ground mat, your own eye and ear protection, and kneeling rolls.

FOR SQUADING PURPOSES, MEMBERS SHARING EQUIPMENT MUST SO INDICATE ON REGISTRATION FORM.

AMMUNITION: All contestants must provide their own ammunition (including arrows).

PROTECTIVE GEAR: All contestants must provide their own eye and ear protective gear. Contestants who do not bring proper protective gear **will not** be allowed to compete.

SCORING PROTEST: Tie-breakers or shoot-off procedures will be based on existing rules (i.e., NRA, ATA.) Air rifle and .22 targets will be posted after scoring for 15 minutes. Scoring protests must be made during that time. When new targets are posted on the scoring board, previous target scores are final.

Safety First Ensures a Fun Shoot for All!

Tri-River Area invitational shoots are strictly for members who have demonstrated a clear understanding of firearms safety. Entry-level shooting sports members should not feel pressured to shoot, and any member who does not fully understand or cannot adhere to the following rules should not compete in Tri-River Area invitational shoots:

1. Muzzles of firearms, whether loaded or not – and archers’ arrows – must NEVER be pointed at any person or in any direction that may cause a ricochet; and must NEVER be brandished (waved in any direction with the muzzle pointed in any direction other than down-range);
2. Participants must understand when it is appropriate to have “action open;”
3. Fingers must ALWAYS remain OFF triggers unless preparing to shoot at a target;
4. Participants must know, understand and follow all range commands given;
5. Participants must understand target shooting sequence.

These basic safety rules are in place to ensure the safety of everyone participating in Tri-River Area invitational shoots – so, if your member isn’t quite yet sure of how to handle firearms safely, please opt out of participating in invitational shoots until you are sure your shooter is a safe shooter. Remember - a safe shoot is a fun shoot!

Directions to the 4-H Shooting Range in Eckert

From Montrose and Grand Junction:

Take Highway 50 to Delta; then take Highway 92 north four miles to Highway 65. Turn left onto Highway 65, toward Eckert. In Eckert, turn left (west) onto North Road at the Big "E" Market, which will be on your right. Follow North Road west and down the hill, straight ahead to Trap Club Road. Turn left and go about ½ mile; the range is on the right.

From Hotchkiss:

Take Highway 92 to Austin; turn right onto Highway 65 and follow the directions from Eckert, above.
