

# 4-H Embryology



## A School Enrichment Program

CSU Extension- Arapahoe County offers several 4-H School Enrichment programs that can be delivered to county classrooms for extra-special fun and learning. These programs are designed to be offered in school by Extension staff and volunteers, and serve to complement curriculum across many disciplines.

### The 4-H Embryology Program:

- Gives students in primary school (grades K-6) the opportunity to learn about chickens, eggs and embryonic development through observation of the egg hatching process.
- Provides a great way for students to observe the development of life in just three weeks.
- Includes a teacher's manual, a dozen eggs, an incubator, brooder, feeder, waterer, heat lamp, feed, shavings and instruction packet.
- Many of the lessons in the manual will help to build children's math, science and language arts skills.
- The cost is \$1.50 per child with a \$25 rental fee for incubator usage.
- The program is only available from March to June each year.
