

# 4-H Mini Greenhouse



## A School Enrichment Program

CSU Extension- Arapahoe County offers several 4-H School Enrichment programs that can be delivered to county classrooms for extra-special fun and learning. These programs are designed to be offered in school by Extension staff and volunteers, and serve to complement curriculum across many disciplines.

### The 4-H Mini-Greenhouse Program:

- Gives students in primary school (grades K-6) the opportunity to learn about plants and seeds through observation of plant growth in a mini-greenhouse.
- Allows students to plant three types of seed in their own greenhouse, observe germination and conduct experiments with the help of a Teacher's Manual.
- Demonstrates what plants need to survive, the function of plant parts and why plants are important for people.
- Many of the lessons in the manual will help to build children's math, science and language arts skills.
- The cost is \$1.75 per kit with a free online Teacher's Guide with every 20 kits purchased.
