A School Enrichment Program

Let your students participate in an exciting, hands-on project. Arapahoe County Extension provides teachers with six school enrichment programs.

The Embryology program is a:

- Fun, rewarding and education program that provides a great way for students to observe the development of life in just three short weeks.
- Gives young children (usually kindergarten and first grade) the opportunity to learn through observation and hands on activities about chickens, eggs and embryonic development.
- Many of the lessons in the teacher/leader manual help build the children's skills in the area of math, science and language arts.
- This three week program includes a teachers manual, dozen eggs, incubator, brooder, feeder, waterer, heat lamp, feed, shavings and instruction packet.
- The cost for this project is \$1.50 per child with a \$25 rental fee for incubator usage.
