To determine who qualifies for State Fair competition, we will be having shoot-offs at the following times and places. You may register until the start of the competition on the day of the shoot, but pre-registration is strongly encouraged, except for shotgun events. If you register on the day of the shoot you will most likely be placed on a later shooting relay. If you cannot attend at the scheduled times refer to the rule on Hardship cases in the Boulder County Shooting Sports Addenda.

You can come to the shoot-offs and compete and not have to be on a state team. We encourage all members to come and enjoy the competition. If you do qualify for a state team and you do not want to go to state you must tell the superintendent at the time of qualifying because registrations for state competition are filled out the same day as shoot-off.

YOU MUST PRACTICE WITH A CERTIFIED 4-H SHOOTING SPORTS INSTRUCTOR WHO IS CERTIFIED IN YOUR DISCIPLINE IN ORDER TO SHOOT AT COUNTY SHOOT-OFF. Your certified leader will have his/her certificate on file at the Extension Office.

A parent **MUST** be in attendance with the 4-H member at each shoot-off. *All shooters will be charged a 2007 one-time fee of \$20.00 at the County shoot-offs that covers all shooting events (except shotgun range fees). All participants will receive a T-Shirt. Depending on the discipline, each state qualifying participant may have additional fees due for the state shoot-offs.*

Hunter's Safety card is required for County Shoot-off and State Fair competition. You **MUST** bring your card with you to EACH shoot-off for inspection upon request.

All shoot-offs will be conducted using the State Fair Contest rules found at <http://www.4h.colostate.edu/ss/> and the Boulder County Addenda to the state rule book found at <http://www.coopext.colostate.edu/boulder/4-Hsite/sspage.htm> .

Air Rifle and Air Pistol will be held at the Boulder County Fairgrounds in the Rabbit Barn (Barn A). Air Rifle and air Pistol competition will be on Friday July 20, 2007 at 3:00 p.m.. Day of the shoot registration starts at 2:00 p.m. and ends at 6:00 p.m.. To pre-register, fill out the enclosed form. Your certified leader **MUST** sign it and then you mail it to: Mike Cook, 970 E. County Rd 8, Berthoud, CO. 80513. Each participant needs to bring his/her own box of pellets, rifle/pistol, safety glasses, kneeling pad. Pre-registration deadline is Monday July 16, 2007. If you have any questions call Mike Cook at 970-532-4787.

Archery will be held at Berthoud Gun club. Archery competition will be on Saturday July 21, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. Day of the shoot registration starts at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 9:00 a.m.. To pre-register, fill out the enclosed form. Your certified leader **MUST** sign it and then you mail it to: Jerry Boldt, 12900 Linda Vista Drive, Longmont, and Co. 80504. Each participant needs to bring his/her own bow, five or more arrows, arm protection, finger protection and a quiver. This year there will be five classifications for Archery: Compound Unlimited, Compound Limited,

Compound Traditional, Recurve Limited, Recurve Traditional (See your coach for definitions of each class). Pre-registration deadline is Monday July 16, 2007. If you have any questions call Jerry Boldt at 303-772-4467.

Archery notes for 2007

- ***You may compete in both compound and recurve at the County shoot-off. If you qualify for state you must pick the single class you will compete in at state.***
- ***If you qualify for the State shoot-off you must supply a scorer for each shooter.***

Muzzleloading will be held at the Berthoud Gun Club. Muzzleloading competition will be on Sunday July 22, 2007 at 8:00 a.m. for Juniors and 9:00 a.m. for Seniors. To pre-register fill out the enclosed form. Your certified leader MUST sign it and then you mail it to: Jeff Stamp, P.O. Box 1198, Longmont, Co. 80502. Each participant needs to bring his/her own rifle with powder and balls, safety glasses, and ear protection. Pre-registration deadline is Monday July 16, 2007. If you have any questions call Jeff Stamp at 303-772-5155.

Shotgun will be held at the Berthoud Gun Club. Shotgun competition will be on Saturday July 21 2007 at 4:00 p.m.. Day of the shoot registration starts at 3:00p.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m.. No pre-registrations will be done. Each participant needs to bring his/her own shotgun, at least 75 rounds of shotgun shells (shot size of 7.5 or 8, or 9 bring extra shells for possible tie breaker shoot off), safety glasses and ear protection. Everyone should plan to shoot 3 rounds and your 2 best scores will be used, and the third round will be used as the first tie-breaker. If you have any questions call Mel Green at 303-532-0956 or 720-494-2210. The cost will be approximately \$3.50 per round.

.22 Rifle will be held at the Berthoud Gun Club. .22 will be on Sunday July 22, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. Day of the shoot registration starts at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 10:00 a.m.. To pre-register, fill out the enclosed form. Your certified leader MUST sign it and then you mail it to: Paul Ross, 1536 Denison Circle, Longmont, and Co. 80503. Each participant needs to bring his/her own rifle, .22 shells (50 rounds), kneeling pad, safety glasses, and ear protection. Pre-registration deadline is Monday July 16, 2007. If you have any questions call Paul Ross at 303-809-0873.

Skeet and 5 stand will be held July 28, 2007, Skeet at Golden Gun Club in Watkins, CO and 5 stand at the Berthoud Gun club. Day of the shoot registration starts at 8:00a.m. and ends at or before 9:00a.m. for skeet. Day of the shoot registration starts at 3:00p.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m. for 5 stand. No pre-registrations will be taken. Your certified leader MUST sign the form below. Each participant needs to bring his/her own shotgun, at least 75 rounds of shotgun shells (shot size of 7.5 or 8, or 9 bring extra shells for possible tie breaker shoot off), safety glasses and ear protection. You will shoot at least 2 rounds but may shoot 3 depending on the number of shooters and the weather conditions. This will be determined the day of the shoot before the competition begins. Berthoud Gun Club - 20498 Weld County Road 1, Berthoud. Located ½ mile south of Hwy, 56 on Road 1 on the East side of the road.

Golden Gun Club – 1503 S. Watkins Road. Watkins is located east of Denver off I-70. Take the I-70-BL N exit- EXIT 295- toward WATKINS. Turn RIGHT onto N WATKINS RD / CR-97 and head South for about 3.5 miles to the Gun Club.
