The Boulder County Extension will be forming a new team to act in an advisory capacity in the area of 4-H/FFA Livestock events at the Boulder County Fair.

4-H/FFA Superintendents will no longer be elected or appointed by the Boulder County Fair Board. This action was taken by the Boulder County Fair Board on Monday, August 20th, 2007.

DaNell Hennis and I will work with this new “Livestock Advisory Team” to formulate rules for the livestock shows, to organize who will supervise the different livestock areas, and we will oversee the 4-H/FFA livestock programming.

We hope that this new approach will do the following:

- Develop more involvement of the 4-H Extension agents/FFA Advisor in livestock programming at the Boulder County Fair and in the youth program overall
- Provide a forum to focus on 4-H/FFA livestock project principles in order to make the best possible decisions on Boulder County junior livestock related issues & conflicts
