18/4 Pak Annuals

Dianthus 'Supra Red' – The beautiful lacy 1-1.5” blooms adorn the 10-12” upright plants; the habit is strongly branching and compact. Early flowering with exceptional garden performance make this a great early season choice. ‘Supra Purple’ was an AAS winner in 2006.

Impatiens 'Shimmer Salmon', 'Shimmer Violet'- Fantastic branching is the hallmark of the all-new Shimmer series. Its strong vigor and excellent branching combine to make for great garden performance. Shimmer will fill baskets and containers quite well too. Consumers will appreciate the large, premium-quality blooms and beautiful colors. The series is very uniform in habit. ‘Shimmer Salmon’ is a **Best of CSU** winner.

Pansy 'Northern Lights' – This **Plant Select** pansy has large flowers in a subtle blend of lemon yellow and lilac with accents of blue. It grows 5-10” tall and up to 10” wide in cool weather. Grow in full sun to part shade in moderately moist soils. It is hardy in zones 2-9.

Pansy 'Blue Velvet' – This **Plant Select** pansy bears velvety navy blue flowers offering a perfect contrast to Northern Lights. It grows 5-10” tall and up to 10” wide in cool weather. Grow in full sun to part shade in moderately moist soils. It is hardy in zones 2-9.

Portulaca 'Stopwatch Mix' - For a neat compact moss rose, you can't beat the Stopwatches. Like a Sundial, each Stopwatch is virtually day-neutral and will flower early enough for spring sales, even in the Deep South. They are unlike the Sundials in that their habit is much more controlled. Very heat tolerant, the Stopwatches will spread to about 1/3-1/2 the size of a Sundial in the garden. Flowers remain open longer into the evening than other Portulacas.

Verbena 'Tuscany Lavender', Tuscany Peach', 'Tuscany White' – These heat and drought-loving plants are naturally compact, well-branched and bushy plants. Growing 8-10 inches tall they are beautiful as a border or in mixed containers. Tuscany Peach will replace ‘Peaches N Cream’ in our selection.

Tomato 'Sunsugar' – A very sweet, golden-orange cherry tomato with thin skin and good crack resistance; the 1 inch fruits are ready in 62 days. It is indeterminate with FT resistance. Great for containers or even hanging baskets!

10/4 Red Jumbo Pak Annuals

Begonia ‘Inferno Rose’, ‘Inferno White’ - Vigorous landscape type Begonias for parks, display gardens, large containers and hanging baskets. Large, showy flowers and shiny, dark foliage combine for an outstanding display in shady gardens; Heat and cold tolerant.

Celosia ‘Smart Look Red’ – A more compact, but better branched plant than New Look, Smart Look is crowned with many neon red plumes over deep bronze foliage. The robust plants have excellent garden performance. Plants reach 20” tall.

Coleus ‘Chocolate Mint’ – This easy-to-grow, dark-leafed plant shows off rich, dark chocolate colored leaves finely edged in soothing mint green. The 12-14 inch plants are well suited to shade gardens and shady container plantings.

Osteospermum ‘Asti White’- All America Selections 2008, Large 2-2 1/2”, pure white daisy flowers with blue centers are borne on graceful stems. Whether grown in planters on patios or annual gardens, ‘Asti White’ exhibits heat and drought tolerance during summer months. Thick fleshy leaves indicate its drought tolerance. ‘Asti White’ is the first white Osteospermum propagated from seed. Like other Osteos, ‘Asti White’ will tolerate slight frost. So it makes them perfect for the spring or fall garden. The plants thrive in a sunny garden, reaching about 17-20 inches tall and wide.

Petunia ‘Baby Duck’ Yellow – This small-flowered spreading petunia is covered with many soft yellow, trumpet-shaped blooms that are 1.5 to 1.75 inch across. The vigorous 10-14 inch plants grow slightly upright, and are an excellent choice to quickly fill landscapes, gardens, and large containers.

Petunia ‘Shock Wave Purple’, ‘Shock Wave Rose’, ‘Shock Wave Buzz’ Mix – These “small but mighty” newcomers are the earliest-to-flower spreading petunia. They are fast-to-fill and deliver the best season-long color impact to create exceptional hanging baskets, container, mixed combos and small-space gardens. Each well branched, mounded plant is blanketed with tons of color from an amazing number of petite (1.5 to 2”), high-impact flowers. Shock Waves show excellent outdoor performance and are the fastest petunias to rebound from overhead watering and rain. The 7-10 inch tall plants spread up to 3 feet.

Salvia ‘Alert Red’ - Here is a salvia to make you stand up and take notice. It is a vigorous growing salvia that withstands Colorado’s extremely dry climate. Long columns of bright red flowers adorn 15” to 18” dark green plants. It thrives in both sun and shade.

Zinnia ‘Benary’s Giant Deep Red’ – This is a tall giant flowered zinnia that you can pick out of a full field of flowers. It is 36” tall with intensely deep, red dahlia type flowers. It is that red that goes with everything new. Zinnias are some of the West’s best bedding plants and this one is a real stunner.

Zinnia ‘Profusion Knee-High Red’ – This taller version of the award winning Profusion series has the same strong garden performance. The bushy, plants grow 8-10” taller to finish out at 18-20”. Profusion Knee-High is a must where a taller landscape plant is needed in a full sun location.

Zinnia ‘Solcito Yellow’- Perfect for landscapes – easy to grow and maintain all season-covered with color all season! Plants stay vigorous and healthy with lots of small, golden daisy like blooms with brown centers topping the lush foliage. It is a great alternative to Sanvitalia or Bidens. Tough and durable, this heat and drought-lover also tolerates cool conditions. Mounding, spreading plants reach 10-12 inches. Solcito reaches 20” across making a great spreading groundcover; also great in containers or baskets. (Ball)

3 ½ Annuals

Angelonia ‘Carita Cascade Deep Purple’, ‘Carita Cascade White’ – This summer snap will add a delightful “Cottage Garden” feel to any garden. ‘Carita Cascade’ series has a trailing growth habit and medium growth vigor reaching 8-10” height and 20-26” width. Exceptional heat tolerance makes Carita great plants for both landscape and container plantings.

Argyranthemum ‘Madeira Crested Red’, ‘Madeira Primrose’ –Madeira Marguerite Daisies are a compact form growing 8-12” tall. They are uniform, full and bushy plants with good garden performance and season-extending qualities for spring and fall. Good branching and early flowering fills container fast. Great for small pots, windowboxes and in mixed combinations. Crested Red has short dense double petals in the center forming a dome with a set of longer daisy petals on the outside. Primrose is a light yellow in a typical daisy form, and a **Best of CSU** winner.

Argyranthemum ‘Molimba Mini Double White’ –“ **Best of Welby**” winner. This compact Marguerite Daisy will bloom all summer with less deadheading. A second flush of growth allows the spent flowers to be buried deep into the foliage greatly reducing the need to clean. 1” fully double, pure white flowers cover the plant; excellent for smaller container combinations or solo pots.

Bacopa ‘Abunda Colossus Lavender’- Abunda’s come by their name naturally. They are loaded with blooms! Colossus Lavender bears large, light purple flowers over dark green leaves. Abunda Bacopa grows 8-12” tall in full sun. They have good branching and heat tolerance; Excellent for mixed containers and hanging baskets.

Begonia Non-Stop ‘Mocca Mix’ - Mocca brings a whole new dimension of beauty and performance to the garden: full, lush chocolate-bronze foliage that lasts from spring till frost, PLUS improved heat tolerance! The big (2 1/2 to 4 inches wide), fully double flowers have all the beauty of roses, and look fantastic against that smoky-dark foliage! The flowers begin in late spring and continue into early summer, adding magnificent over-the-top beauty to the home, patio or deck. Just 10 inches high

and 12 to 15 inches wide, these plants are compact yet still make a huge impact, their large, lush foliage filling the available space nicely. And unlike many Begonias, it won't flop or melt if seriously hot weather arrives early in your climate. The heat tolerance is amazing! Truly a designer plant that is easy for everyone.

Calibrachoa 'Callie Orange', Small flowers on trailing plants grow 4-8" tall by 12-16" wide. Callies are ideally suited for containers, baskets and components in mixed combinations. They flower early and long. Callies are covered with blooms all summer long. Orange 08 is a deep dark orange.

Calibrachoa 'Minifamous Compact Dark Red' - Very deep red flowers carpet dark green foliage. This calibrachoa performs well in both containers and in ground beds because of its close cropped habit. Leaves seem to stack up on one another as it only grows 2-4" tall, but spreads out to 16" wide. This class of calibrachoa is finally making the species into a true bedding plant.

Calibrachoa 'Minifamous Double Pink'- The only double flowered Calibrachoa on the market. The extra set of petals make a fuller flower. It is great for mixed baskets and containers.

Calocephalus brownii 'Silver Bush' – Interesting silvery foliage and unusual structure give this 6-10" plant its claim to fame. Silver Bush is extra heat-tolerant so it is great in full sun gardens as a border or mid range plant.

Cleome 'Spirit Appleblossom' - Best of Show at CSU. A solid mass of delicate light pink blooms make a breathtaking border! The leaves of this 24-30" tall, traditional Cleome have a silvery cast, and the delicate, feathery flowers add grace to the space. Spirits prefer bright light but will tolerate part shade in hot conditions; a lovely addition to the back of beds and also a very durable container plant.

Coleus 'Big Red Judy' – One of the largest Coleus varieties, Big Red Judy is a bold, textural plant with rich red leaves and an upright habit. Reaching 24-36" tall it is an impressive grower!

Coleus 'Splish-Splash' – You'll love Splish Splash's mottled, vibrant red and lime green colors. A strong habit growing upright to 18-30".PW

Coleus 'Tilt & Twist' – The fun shapes of the foliage of this coleus gives it, its name. It also sports a wide array of vibrant colors from chartreuse to red that become even more evident in the summer sun. This was specifically bred to stand up to summer heat! Twist and Twirl will certainly cause the WOW affect!

Cuphea 'Rico' Red – Mounding plants with loads of bright red flowers make this a great accent plant. Rico has exceptional heat tolerance and improved edema resistance.

Growing 12-16" tall and wide it is great to use in containers or baskets, solo or in combinations. Replaces Samba.

Duranta 'Lime' - The lime color of this Duranta is hard to beat in the landscape. Duranta is in the verbena family and is native to tropical America. It reaches about 12 inches tall, spreading outward about the same distance. You'll grow the Duranta for colorful foliage that lights up the front of the border in a landscape like few other plants can do. Several Duranta varieties have been picked by Athens Select and the Texas Super Star plant programs emphasizing its ability to take extreme summer conditions. It is listed as a zone 8-11 plant. If you live in a colder areas it is fantastic as an annual border or filler in containaners.

Heliotrope 'Helo' Blue - We changed to this variety because of the great fragrance and there are more flowers to give off the lovely scent! The plant foliage is a bolder green color.

Jamesbrittenia 'Britney Grand Red' - Welby has listed this as an upright Bacopa. It looks much like Bacopa and is used in the same ways; in baskets, windowboxes and containers, however it is more mounding-trailing in habit than Bacopa. An abundance of large, vivid-colored flowers cover the compact but branched stems. It thrives in full sunlight with better heat tolerance than Bacopa.

Ipomea 'Sweet Carolina Bewitched' - This is another addition to the great Sweet Caroline Sweet Potato line. Bewitched is a dark leaf, with a shape that is reminiscent of a lobed ivy leaf. It has the same great compact habit of the other Sweet Carolina varieties.

Oplismenus 'Dragonfly' - Great foliage plant for texture in combinations. The cascading foliage is green with white striping and reddish hues. Grows 6-10" high with vigorous trailing stems. Good in sun or shade baskets window boxes or planters.

Nierembergia 'Lara White' - This white flowering nierembergia loves high light and warm temperatures. Lara forms nice low mounds of dark, thin foliage that is covered with pure white cupped flowers.

Petunia 'Blanket Zinfandel' - This is a new color addition to the 'Blanket' line of Petunias that Welby has been growing. Blankets flowers completely cover the 3-4 foot vining stems. The non-stop flowers are the color of a Red Zinfandel wine. And much like the wine this Petunia will be very popular with everyone! Blankets trail profusely out of baskets or planters.

Petunia 'Mini- Me Red' - The concept of the Mini-Me petunia series is to present a natural petunia that will give the same results of calibrachoa, while maintaining all the benefits of petunias. The varieties produce tiny flowers, and for some, these will be even smaller than those found with calibrachoa. Mini-Me has a large amount of flowers, appearing above the plant's foliage. Plants will be quite compact, measuring from about 4 to 8 inches high. Plants are half hanging with small foliage and flowers. The small size

makes them more resistant to rainy conditions than other lines. They are great in hanging baskets and solo or mixed containers.

Petunia ‘Music Purple Twist’ – True purple veined flowers on a spreading-type petunia meant we had to add this one! It was also a top pick of many trials and of many growers. The flowers sit on top of the foliage and are so prolific that they almost cover the foliage completely. Music Purple Twist will grow 8-10” high by 2-3’ wide. Great for baskets or trailing out of containers as well as a wonderful filler in landscape beds.

Petunia ‘Potunia Neon Rose’, ‘Potunia Pink’, ‘Potunia Deep Purple’, ‘Potunia Red’ – The ‘Potunia’ series is gaining rave reviews as the choice for the best mounding petunia on the market. ‘Potunias’ hold a full canopy of flowers and remain mounding at the same time. They are tolerant of cold temps and are very mildew resistant. Its rounded plant habit and intense flower power make this series the perfect choice for hanging baskets or pots.

Petunia ‘SuperCal Terracotta’, ‘SuperCal Rose’, ‘SuperCal Velvet’ – SuperCal is the first series in an all-new flower class that delivers the best characteristics of the favorite petunia and calibrachoa: strong vigor, exceptional flower power, lush foliage, dependable performance and a range of unique colors. **SuperCal** petunias are bred to deliver maximum performance. The **SuperCal** petunia series combines terrific outdoor performance with the high-impact colors. New **SuperCal Terracotta** is a terrific color, a **Best of CSU** winner...and with other vibrant colors like Neon Rose and Velvet, landscapes, containers and baskets will take on a whole new- look. **SuperCal** petunias are easier to handle because they have no sticky residue on the leaves like standard petunias. Excellent disease tolerance and outstanding performance in all types of weather extremes mean gardeners and landscapers will be satisfied all season.

Petunia ‘Tiny Tunia Cabernet’ – We love the Tiny Tunias and this is another great color in the line. Cabernet is a burgundy-wine shade. Tiny Tunias are great in baskets and containers either solo or mixed.

Salvia f. ‘Cathedral Sky Blue’ – This series is an exceptional selection that is more compact in habit with larger flower size than other varieties. The light slate blue 3” spikes are held on upright plants 16-20 inches tall.

Talinum paniculatum ‘Limon’ – This unique plant is a “must-have” for its brilliant display of mounded, bright, lime-green leaves. **Limon** also features airy inflorescences covered in tiny rose-pink flowers. Quick and easy to grow, this tough, vigorous plant handles stress well, including heat and drought; the leaf color is even more vibrant when water, feed or light are stressed. It is well-suited to containers, baskets or in ground plantings. Good as a fresh or dried cut flower! It grows to 28-32 inches with flowers with a spread of up to 4 feet.

Verbena ‘Lanai Lavender Star’, ‘Lanai Purple Star’ – Lanai’s feature a trailing growth habit with non-stop color in the landscape. They have exceptional powdery

mildew resistance too, keeping them looking better longer in the landscape. Lanai's will grow 6-10" tall with a 20-24" spread. Both Lavender Star and Purple Star have a white eye with white stripes on the petal edges giving them a star pattern. **Lavender Star is a Best of CSU winner.**

Viola 'Velocity Lavender w/ Yellow Eye', 'Lemon & Plum Picotee'- Velocity violas will flourish from the early spring through the heat of summer, and will still be blooming at first frost in the fall! These heat tolerant violas are perfect for spring and summer beds and containers. Velocity is ideal in baskets, containers and window boxes because of its mounding, trailing habit. Marvelous and long lasting in the landscape, they are sure to please!

4 1/2' Annuals

Asparagus meyeri – This is not new to the industry but just a new addition to the Welby line. Foxtail sprengeri fern has leaves that form densely along the stem, making a "tail-like" foliage appearance. It is great as filler in mixed baskets or containers for full sun to shade.

Begonia boliviensis 'Bellfire' – "Best of CSU" winner. Beautiful dangling Salmon Pink flowers at the ends of gracefully upright-arching stems with very dark green (almost black) foliage make a stunning plant. 'Bellfire' has a more upright habit than 'Bonfire' and is a little more vigorous. The outstanding performance in all climates, including humid summer heat, makes this a "must-have" plant for the shade garden. It is fabulous in containers and hanging baskets.

Begonia 'Frinzies Cindy Fringed', 'Frinzies Janny Fringed' – The fringed flower edge gives these Reiger-type begonias a unique look. Cindy is a pink flowering Begonia and Janny is a salmon with rose tints near the edges of outside petals. Both are fully double flowered and bear lots of beautiful blooms in the full shade. Great for containers.

Begonia 'Solenia Dark Pink', 'Solenia Velvet Red' – Last year we added the Solenia series to our line of Reiger Begonias. We were so pleased with the line that decided to not only continue the line this year but add 2 more colors to it, Dark Pink and Velvet Red. All Reiger's should be grown in the shade.

Begonia 'Amstel Blitz Yellow' – We chose this yellow flowered Reiger Begonia because the color is so intense. We think it is the best yellow out there. All Reiger's should be grown in the shade.

Cordyline 'Red Star' – The sword-shaped leaves of ruby red to burgundy, give this versatile plant its handsome looks and a hardy constitution. Year-round color makes Red Star sparkle in landscapes and containers. Cordyline is gaining popularity with people who are looking for splashes of vibrant color, or something a little different for centers of containers. Can reach 3-4' tall in part shade.

Dahlia ‘Goldalia Scarlet’- A ”**Best of Welby**” winner. This dynamic bicolor flower will “wow” your customers. Godalia has a compact growth habit with excellent branching making a full and busy plant. Godalia Scarlet has bright red outer petals with thinner yellow double petals around the golden center. It has very good outdoor performance in beds and containers.

Dahlia ‘Mystic Illusion’- Mystic Illusion is a real knockout and named the **Best New Variety at CSU!** The bright yellow flower petals are set off against the flower’s nearly black center and the plants dark foliage. Mystic’s intriguing contrast of dark foliage and intense flower color makes a powerful statement in the garden. The 8-10” tall plants are great in borders or smaller pots. Dahlias prefer part sun.

Osteospermum ‘Summertime Blueberry’, ‘Summertime Sunset’ – Summertime has been bred for improved heat tolerance, natural branching, and a round mounding habit, plus new exciting colors! ‘Summertime Blueberry’ displays deep shades of purples and yellows and as the bloom matures it turns to different shades of blue. ‘Summertime Sunset’ has yellow and/ or soft orange flowers with hints of rose at the base of the petals with purple centers. Summertime exhibits superb garden performance throughout the summer in containers, landscape beds and combination planters.

4 ½” Geraniums

Geranium, Regal ‘Aristo Halo Bicolor Purple’, ‘Aristo Lilac’, ‘Aristo Velvet Red’, ‘Aristo Salmon’ - Aristo bears flamboyant blooms above the dense luxuriant foliage. The rich colors and non-stop blooming make these perfect for indoor decorations or outdoor containers. In our deep 4 ½” pots.

Geranium ‘Tricolor’ – The unique leaves of green with a white edging and band of rose over the green towards the outside of the leaf are sure to get many “ohhs” and “ahhs” from customers. Pair that with the bold scarlet red blooms and you have a winner! Bold and exotic really describe this plant. In our deep 4 ½” pots.

Geranium Ivy, ‘Minicascade Red’, ‘Minicascade Pink’ – A vigorous mounding habit produces a big globes of color. Minicascade is one of the most floriferous ivies on the market. The semi-double flowers in clear bright colors cover the plants. In our standard red 4 ½” pots.

Geranium ‘Moonlight Strawberry Blush’ – **Best of Welby.** Moonlight has brilliant colors on dark foliage with outstanding garden performance. It is early to flower with a uniform plant habit. Strawberry Blush’s flowers are so rich and bright it is reminiscent of a Regal geranium. In our standard red 4 ½” pots.

10/4 Perennials

Rudbeckia hirta ‘Denver Daisy’ – This is a special introduction from PlantSelect, specifically chosen to commemorate the City and County of Denver’s 150th birthday on Nov 22, 2008! This plant is the progeny of Rudbeckia hirta, a Colorado native, and

Rudbeckia 'Prairie Sun'. An abundance of bright, golden petals brushed with strokes of rustic red surrounding a deep eye create attractive 6-8 inch flowers in the landscape. At 22-26" tall and 15-20 inches wide, the Denver Daisy makes an eye-catching statement in the garden or a large container. Once established, Denver Daisy thrives in hot, sunny areas with minimal moisture. For summer-long color, transplant or sow into the garden once the risk of frost has passed. Also available in our 6X Red pot.

Rudbeckia hirta 'Radiance' - bears double petaled flowers in a beautiful dark golden yellow color. The unique quilled petals give this plant an unusual look. Grows 18-24" tall. Great for natural looking landscapes and in xeric gardens.

4 1/2' Perennials

Clematis integrifolia 'Mongolian Bells' – This **Plant Select** choice is a very compact form of the common herbaceous species. It is available in a spectrum of colors (including pink, white, lavender and blue) that bloom from May to September. Growing 10-14" tall it makes the perfect edging or mounding clump in a border or Xeriscape garden. Mongolian Bells forms attractive seed heads in late summer and fall. Plant this Clematis in full sun to part shade in moderate to dry loamy soils. It is hardy in zones 3-9.

Nepeta 'Little Trudy'- This **Plant Select** hybrid catnip was selected at Little Valley Wholesale Nursery for its distinctive serrated, silvery foliage and long season of lavender bloom. Little Trudy will bloom from April to October in full sun to part shade. It is hardy in zones 4-9 and thrives under average or xeric conditions. It is the most compact catnip cultivar, growing only 8-10" tall and 12-16" wide.

Scrophularia macrantha Red Birds In A Tree – This **Plant Select** plant was introduced in 1996. This rare penstemon cousin has showy crimson tubular flowers which are produced in generous sprays above rich green serrated foliage. It reaches 36" tall and 18" wide in full sun to part shade. This south-western uplands wildflower has shown great adaptability in gardens, but does best in moderate to dry conditions. It is hardy in zones 4-9.

Achillea 'Tutti Frutti Pink Grapefruit', 'Tutti Frutti Pomegranate' - These vigorous, mound-forming Yarrow were bred for their compact habit, strong stature and wonderful flower uniformity. 'Pink Grapefruit' has rose flowers that fade to a light rose., 'Pomegranate' is a striking magenta color unlike any other. Both will reach 29" in height and approximately 28 inches spread. Both overwintered successfully in Zone 5. Yarrow grows best in full sun and drier conditions. A **Blooms of Bressingham** variety.

Helianthus 'Hartwood Ruby' – This **Blooms of Bressingham** variety displays bright, saucer-shaped flowers that are true velvety red with bright-gold stamens from May to July. They may reflower in fall. Plants form low cushions of narrow, glossy, evergreen foliage 6-8 inches tall.

Sedum ‘Lemon Coral’ – Needle-shaped leaves form spikes of light yellow green. Similar to ‘Angelina’, but brighter yellow and more upright and uniform in habit. Also less brittle when handling. Grows 6-8” tall in full sun to part sun. Hardy in Zones 3-11.

Silene ‘Firefly’ – **Blooms of Bressingham** introduction. The dark magenta-red 1” double flowers bloom in mid-spring on long stems above the foliage. Vigorous upright plants with strong stems and gray-green foliage reaches 30” in height by 24 inches spread. Grows best in full sun. Hardy to zone 5. Use in the middle or back of flower beds or mass in the landscape.

Rose Mini ‘Constellation’ - Near white, fragrant mini with dark, glossy leaves and upright growth. Grows 22” tall. Hardy in Zones 5-10.

RoseMini ‘Denver’s Dream’– A tall, vigorous plant continually producing dazzling coppery-orange flowers. Grows 30” tall. Hardy in Zones 4-10.

Rose Mini ‘Gala’ - Bright cerise pink blooms of superb Hybrid Tea form. A spreading habit with semi-glossy dark green foliage. Grows to 18” tall. Hardy in Zones 4-10.

Rose Mini ‘Herbies’ - Lavender blooms with a rosy blush come one to a stem continuously for a fantastic cutting garden display. Grows to 24” tall. Hardy in Zones 6-10.

Rose Mini ‘Iced Raspberry’ - Raspberry red petals with white on the reverse. 1 ½” Hybrid Tea-form flowers. Vibrant, long-lasting color as a cut flower. Grows to 14-20” tall. Hardy in Zones 5-10.

Rose Mini ‘Sorcerer’- Bright, medium-red blooms of eye-catching form are borne singly and in clusters. Grows to 20” tall. Hardy in Zones 4-11.

Rose Mini ‘Y2K’ – Deep Yellow fragrant flowers reach about two inches wide when fully open. Grows to 14” tall. Hardy in Zones
