4-H HORSE SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS

Individuals may be nominated for Outstanding Sportsmanship Award. Nomination applications will be available at the 4-H Horse Show Office at the Fair. There will be 4 divisions: Junior (age 8-10); Intermediate (age 11-13); Senior (age 14-18); and Adult (4-H parents/volunteers). Completed nomination applications will be accepted at the 4-H Horse Show office at the Fair or at the Extension Office. A committee selected by the Horse Advisory Committee will review the nominations and select the award recipients. Things that should be considered when nominating individuals include: helpfulness, positive attitude, cooperation, punctuality, work ethic, conduct, etc. Sportsmanship Awards will be awarded to the recipients at the Large Animal Awards Night.
