SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION OF INTENT CONTRACT

I understand that, if selected, I will not receive any payment until after completion of my first quarter or semester of study with sufficient academic standing to warrant continuation of study. I further understand that the sum of the scholarship will be paid each year as follows:

Equal payments over a four-year period, or in the case of a less than four-year degree program, the scholarship will be divided equally among number of quarters or semesters of full-time course load required for graduation.

If selected, I understand that I am agreeing to send a copy of my grades to the Foundation Board, each semester/quarter, for the board's review and that if, in the Board's opinion, I am not deserving of the scholarship, the remaining balance may be canceled. I also agree that if I find it necessary or advantageous to transfer to a different college, university, or vocational school other than the first selection, I must notify the Board by letter in order to be eligible for the remaining, unused portion of the scholarship. I will notify the Board in writing if I do not attend school in the fall after being awarded the scholarship. I will also notify the Board in writing if I choose to not re-enroll in post-secondary education for a semester. If I do not adhere to the above, I will forfeit the scholarship. I have one year upon being awarded a scholarship to enroll in an accredited, degree-granting college, university or vocational school anywhere in the United States.

I have reviewed these requirements, the scholarships available, and am agreeing to satisfy all required of me in order to receive any scholarship that might be awarded to me.
