



## Catch-A-Lamb

The Catch-A-Lamb contest is open to any eligible 4-Her that is age 8 through 17 as of January 1, 2008. Those participating will be divided into three age categories: 8-10 (Jr), 11-13 (int) and 14-17 (Sr) years of age. A maximum of 6 lambs will be divided among participants.

4-Hers may catch only once per age category. You will not keep the lamb caught at the contest but will receive your lamb in April. You do not have to be enrolled in a 4-H market sheep this year in order to participate in the contest, but you must enroll in Market Sheep in 2008-2009 4-H year, if you catch a lamb in the contest.

If you are interested, you will need to make sure you have the facilities (pens, water, shade, etc.) to care for a sheep project. Also you and your parents are required to sign a contract with the Lamb Committee stating that you have the facilities and the finances to care for a sheep project. Four letters are required to the sponsor(s) of your catch-it-project. (1) when you get your lamb, (1) end of May (1) end of June (1) by the end of Aug. after fair. Catch-a-Lamb applications are subject to the review of the lamb committee. Please **return the entry form by June 13, 2008** – a contract will then be sent to you and your parents.
