**4-H Program Update from Joel Plath, Interim County Director and Southern Region Director**  
You are probably aware that the 4-H year is from October 1 through September 30. Insurance coverage for 4-H members, leaders, and other volunteers covers the same period. After September 30 each year all leaders and youth enroll or re-enroll in 4-H and pay the appropriate fees and insurance premiums.

Given the uncertainty regarding El Paso County (EPC) funding for CSU Extension in 2009, some changes in enrollment/re-enrollment are being made. If EPC does not provide sufficient funding for 2009 to keep the Extension office open and staffed at an acceptable level, the Extension office will close and programming will cease—4-H, horticulture, agriculture, nutrition and food safety, etc. It may be mid-December before we know if sufficient funding will be available.

Therefore, 4-H enrollment forms from 4-H members, leaders, and other volunteers for the 4-H year starting October 1, 2008, will NOT be accepted by the Extension office until further notice. The Extension office will not accept enrollment forms or fees for the 2009 year until we are certain the Extension office will be open in 2009.

This also means that EPC 4-H members, leaders, and other volunteers will NOT be able to participate in 4-H events or activities, whether in EPC or elsewhere, after September 30, 2008; they would not officially be 4-H members, leaders, and other volunteers, nor would they be covered by the 4-H insurance or liability protection from Colorado State University. This "inability to participate" applies to "Colorado Leadership Camp" and other upcoming 4-H events and activities.

Extension clientele may wish to communicate their concerns to their local elected officials regarding this situation.

Furthermore, the state policy is that if a county Extension Program is shut down because of lack of funding, 4-H members residing in that county will be allowed to join 4-H in a neighboring county only if they have been participating in the 4-H program in the neighboring county, in which case they may continue to do so with the approval of the Extension Office in the county in which they have been participating.

### Achievement Celebration

Everyone is invited to a celebration of all of our 4-Hers' achievements for the 2007-2008 program year which will be held on Sunday, October 26 from 3-5 pm at Skyview Middle School. We are proceeding with this event even though we will not be accepting enrollments for the 2009 4-H year at this point. We are doing this because this celebration is the final even of the 2008 4-H year. Its purpose is to recognize the achievements of those who participated in 4-H and who helped make it a success. Special event insurance is being sought to cover this event. Awards that will be given out include State Champions, State Reserve Champions, State Grand Champions and State Reserve Grand Champions for all projects, Grand and Reserve Grand Champions for State Contests, Horse Achievement Award, Livestock Record Book Awards, Catch-It Calf Awards, Supreme Champions, Champion Producer, Premier Exhibitor, Sportsmanship Awards, and Herdsmanship Awards. Other awards are Club Awards, Leader and Member Longevity Awards, and Outstanding 4-H'ers and Leaders for 2007-2008. Join the group for a festive afternoon complete with cake and punch! Skyview Middle School is location at 6350 Windom Peak Blvd. Take Powers to Stetson Hill Blvd. and go East. Take the first left on Tutt. Drive north to Snowy River. Turn right on Snowy River. Continue to the end of the street. The school parking lot will be straight ahead.

### Cooperative Extension History

The following is some historical information about the formation of Extension Offices that may be helpful in understanding why it is so important that the county provide their portion of the funding formula.

On May 8, 1914 President Woodrow Wilson signed the Smith-Lever Act, establishing the Cooperative Extension Service to bring University services to the people. Not the well-to-do elite, but the common people. Higher education had been reserved for the elite but the land-grant university established under the provisions of the first and second Morrill Land-Grant College Acts in 1862 and 1890 provided an opportunity for the children of the working man for higher education. Cooperative Extension made available to those not attending the university access to the knowledge being taught there.

Extension was designed as a partnership of the land-grant universities and the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). Counties are part of the system as a legal third partner. Today Extension partners with county, state and federal governments forming a partnership where each partner has a specific role in funding, staffing and programming. This information is readily available in a book titled "Taking the University to the People" by Wayne D. Rasmussen.

There is a commitment to the community that the county partner makes. A commitment of service. It is the men and women at the county level - the local agriculturalist, home economist, 4-H leader, community and rural development specialist - who actually carry the university to the people.

### Attention CSU Freshmen

CSU Freshmen who have been 4-H'ers can apply to be at 4-H Scholar. Scholars promote the positive experiences they had in 4-H and spend up to 20 hrs a month representing 4-H at key activities. Each Scholar receives training, public relations support materials, reimbursement of expenses and a \$1,500 annual stipend. ## Horse and Livestock

### Horse and Livestock Record Books

Horse and Livestock Record books are due to the Extension Office graded (grading sheets are available at <http://elpaso.colostate.edu>) from the club/project leaders on September 12<sup>th</sup> (we will be open that day - even though it's a Friday). Your clubs/project leaders will require you to hand the books into them at an earlier date so that they have time to grade them before handing them in to the office. I would like clubs to hand their books in together so please do not bring your book into the Extension Office and drop it off. Record books will only be accepted from your club or project leader. Un-graded books will also not be accepted. Leaders please grade all books as having the feedback to your members assists in the learning process.



With the new online record books I have been receiving some questions regarding how many books need to be filled out. The policy has NOT changed and is the same as the last several years. ONLY put one market project per book and put the breeding project in a separate book per species. Do not put both in the same book because it causes difficulty when grading. Remember for some projects a supplement is required and is available on the state website <http://colorado4h.org>. Also you may find it helpful to download the Record Users Guide for Livestock/Horse e-records which is also available on the state website. This guide has helpful information you can use to assist you in filling the books out.

Leaders - when you get questions please refer to the Organizational Leaders Handbook and review the Horse and Livestock Record Book Policy. Score sheets have been emailed out. Hard copies are available at the Extension Office.
