Enrollment Information

- Members must be enrolled in a club and attend club meetings
- Enrollment takes place from **late September to the 1st Friday in May**
- Enroll as soon as possible because some clubs fill up quickly!
- All 4-Hers must enroll in at least one project
- The enrollment fee is \$40.00 per member (financial assistance may be available)

How do I join?

- Select a 4-H club (or clubs) from the El Paso County 4-H Clubs List that you would like to find out more about (which can be found on our website, see below.)
- Call the 4-H Leader for the club(s) you have selected. Ask questions like:
 - Do you have space for additional members?
 - What are the ages of the members in the club?
 - Where and when does the club meet?
 - What type of projects do club members generally complete?
 - What are the club requirements?
- Select a club that you feel is compatible with your family.
- Work with the leader of that club to facilitate getting your child(ren) enrolled in 4-H.
