- ____ 15. Cucumbers, pickling – approximately 1-1/4" diameter, 3-1/2" long (3)
- ____ 17. Cucumbers, slicing – approximately 2-1/2" diameter, 6–9" long (2)
- ____ 19. Eggplant – with stem (2)
- ____ 21. Muskmelon/cantaloupe – no stem (1)
- ____ 23. Onions, yellow – tops 1", do not peel (5)
- ____ 25. Onions, white – tops 1", do not peel (5)
- ____ 27. Peas – with stem (12 pods)
- ____ 28. Peppers, bell – 1" stem (2)
- ____ 31. Peppers, chili – any variety, 1/2" stem (3)
- ____ 33. Pumpkin – with stem (1)
- ____ 35. Squash, summer – yellow or other summer squash of same type, with stem, brush clean (2)
- ____ 37. Squash, summer – zucchini, 1/4"- 1/2" stem, brush clean (2)
- ____ 39. Squash, winter – of same type, with stems (2)
- ____ 41. Tomatoes, green – stems removed (5)
- ____ 43. Tomatoes, ripe – stems removed (5)
- ____ 44. Turnips – leave taproot and 1" tops (5)
- ____ 47. Watermelon – with stem (1)
- ____ 49. Other garden crop – identified (3 entries of same vegetable required for a new class)
