RULES:

Eligibility:

1. All 4-H members enrolled in Clothing Construction and Artistic Clothing projects are expected to participate in Fashion Revue.
2. Members enrolled in Heritage Arts, Shooting Sports, Leathercraft or other projects who make a wearable garment or accessory are encouraged to participate in Fashion Revue.
3. Ages for Fashion Revue Divisions are different than for interview judging. **Check class ages carefully when marking class number on Fashion Revue Entry. Classes may be adjusted based on entry numbers.**
4. Cloverbud members may participate by wearing the item made at Cloverbud Workshop held in July.

Entries:

1. Entries in Constructed Clothing classes will be projects in Clothing Construction, Heritage Arts, and Leathercraft.
2. Entries in Creative Clothing will be projects in Decorate Your Duds, Creative Sewing, Create Your Own, or Style of Your Own.
3. **Fashion Revue entries are due Wednesday, July 15.** Entries and narratives can be submitted by email FAX, mail or in person.

Judging:

1. Participants will be notified of their Judging Schedule by July 22.
2. Only Champion and Reserve Champion will be announced for each class.
3. Premium will be \$3.00 for participation.
4. Members participating in Fashion Revue must exhibit the garment at the Morgan County Fair to complete their project and receive premium.

5. Judges will designate 2 entries from Class 19 and/or 22 for participation in the State Fashion Revue on Saturday, August 22, in Pueblo.
