### General Livestock Rules:

- No animal or tack will be housed or stalled at the Fairgrounds prior to 12:00 p.m., Sunday August 2. Excluding Breeding Sheep, Breeding and Market Goats
- Pre-entering more livestock than you plan to show at the fair will not entitle you to more stall space.
- All youth showing in livestock (excluding horse projects) will sign up for showmanship classes prior to judging at the county fair.
- Youth in horse projects must enter in showmanship if they want to compete in that division.
- Youth exhibiting ANY livestock/market animal (excluding horse) must return the Youth Meat Quality Assurance Certification form with exhibitor and parent signature.

### Rabbits:

- All rabbits must have a permanent legible ear mark in the ear. No duplicate ear numbers can be used.
- A permanent marking pen is acceptable to use.

### Market Goats & Market Sheep:

- Maximum of 6 head per exhibitor.
- If an exhibitor has 1-3 animals, they will receive one pen. If they have 4-6 animals, a maximum of 2 pens are available.

### Swine:

- Maximum of 4 head per exhibitor.
- Market swine must be at the fairgrounds by 6:00 p.m. Sunday, August 2
- If an exhibitor has 1-2 animals, they will receive one pen. If they have 3-4 animals, a maximum of 2 pens are available.
