SHOW RULES

1. Only bona fide 4-H & FFA members 8-18 years old are eligible to exhibit or compete in the Lamb and Goat weight classes.
2. The swine show will run under the rules and regulations of the CJSA.
3. The judge shall place each class as he/she sees fit. ***In all cases the judge's decision is final.***
4. Entry fees: \$15.00/head for all species.
5. Stall space available (\$20 cleaning deposit required per family. Separate check please) Swine must be stalled.
6. Prospect lambs must be slick shorn with ¼ inch or less.
7. All livestock will be in good health. Any found with evidence of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases will be refused entry and must leave the grounds immediately. All out of state livestock will be accepted only with an Official Health certificate with an Entry Permit Number signed by a licensed Veterinarian.

SHOWMANSHIP RULES

1. Showmanship fees: \$5.00 100% payout for showmanship classes.
2. In showmanship classes, the exhibitor ***must*** show his/her own animal.

LAMB & GOAT

3. Novice contestants are those age 5-7 as of January 1, 2009.
4. Junior contestants are those age 8-10 as of January 1, 2009.
5. Intermediate contestants are those age 11-13 as of January 1, 2009.
6. Senior contestants are those age 14-18 as of January 1, 2009.

SWINE

7. Novice contestants are those age 5-8 as of January 1, 2009.
8. Junior contestants are those age 9-12 as of January 1, 2009.
9. Intermediate contestants are those age 13-16 as of January 1, 2009.
10. Senior contestants are those age 17-21 as of January 1, 2009.
