HORSE CLUB MEMBERS
REQUIREMENTS

OCTOBER-DECEMBER

- 1.) *4-H Enrollment Form, Animal Care & Housing Form, and \$25 Enrollment Fee*, are required before attending any horse club activities or meetings.
(Enrollment fee goes up to \$35 on January 1, 2009)

JUNE

- 2.) *Horse I.D. forms* due June 1, 2009 to 4-H Office.
It is recommended to I.D. more than one horse as a back-up.
- 3.) *4-H Horse Record Book* due for 4-H Exhibit Days on Friday, July 17, 5:00pm, Community/Senior Center.
- 4.) *4-H Horse Record Book* to be picked up from 4-H Exhibit Days on Saturday, July 18, 5:00pm, Community/Senior Center.
- 5.) *Level 1 Riding & Written tests* must be passed BEFORE attending practices. Tests must be on file with the 4-H Office. Level 2 is encouraged but not required for all horse club members in Summit County 4-H.

JULY

- 6.) All horse club members are expected to participate in our annual 4-H Horse Show, tentatively set for, Saturday, July 25.
- 7.) All horse club members are expected to fully participate in your club requirements for community service, fundraisers, meetings, activities to be in "good standings" and eligible to participate in the 4-H Horse Show.

AUGUST

- 8.) Level 2 is required for all 4-H members competing in State Fair and Level 3 is required for Western Riding, Reining, Hunt Seat Equitation over jumps and Hunter Hack.

OCTOBER

- 9.) Completed Horse Record Books are due to your 4-H Leader by October 1.

GENERAL RULES

- 10.) A certified equestrian helmet with safety harness fastened in place is required in over fences classes and gymkhana events, activities and practice sessions.
- 11.) All practices, events, activities must be pre-approved with a completed "4-H Sponsored Activity/Event Liability Release Form" on file with the 4-H Office.
(Usually completed by 4-H Club Leader)
- 12.) All 4-H Horse Club members need to understand and study from the 2008 4-H Horse Manual (\$8.00) and the 2006 4-H Horse Rule Book (\$5.00). These books are available in your 4-H Office.
