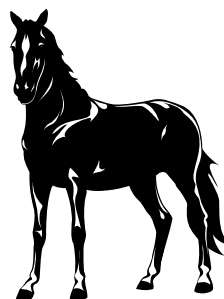

CONSENT WAIVER, RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT FOR EQUINE ACTIVITIES

If Participant in under 18 years old on the Date of the Event then Participant's Parent or Legal Guardian (the "Parent") must complete this CONSENT WAIVER, RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT FOR EQUINE ACTIVITIES

1. I, the undersigned Participant or Parent, voluntarily consent to the participation of the Participant in the Horse Shows, Horse Riding Activities and Competitive Horse Racing and/or Jumping Event held on the Date of Event written above at the (circle one) Summit County Fairgrounds or Breckenridge Equestrian Center, (the "Equine Activity").

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2. I acknowledge that the Equine Activity that Participant will be participating in is **HAZARDOUS** and involves risk of physical injury and property damage. I further acknowledge and affirm that Participant has the ability to engage safely in the Equine Activity and that Participant has the ability to safely manage the particular animal that Participant will use to participate in the Equine Activity.

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3. In consideration of Participant's being permitted to participate in the Equine Activity: I agree to release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the below-defined Released Parties for injuries or damages sustained by Participant or Parent; I agree to assume all risks associated with Participant's participation in the Equine Activity; I agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Summit County 4-H Program, Summit County Government, CSU Extension, The Board of Governors of the Colorado State University System, Colorado State University, the Town of Breckenridge, the State of Colorado, and the City and County of Denver, their respective subdivisions, agents, officers, directors, owners, contractors, volunteers and employees (collectively the "Released Parties") from any and all liability actions, causes of action, debts, claims and demands of every kind and nature whatsoever which may arise during the course or as a result of Participant's participation in the Equine Activity, and; I agree that Participant shall comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the Released Parties regarding participation in the Equine Activity.

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4. Nothing in this Consent, Waiver, Release from Liability, and Indemnity Agreement for Equine Activities shall constitute a waiver or limitation on any right or immunities possessed by the Released Parties pursuant to sections 13-21-119, C.R.S., 24-10-101, et seq., C.R.S, and/or any other any other applicable legal authority.

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5. This Release of Liability is governed by the laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible and shall be binding to the fullest extent of the law. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any legal action arising from Participant's participation in the Equine Activity shall be in the District Court of Summit County, Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined unenforceable, all other parts shall be given full force and effect.

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WARNING

Under Colorado Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.

Youth Helmet & Age Requirement Policy

Summit County 4-H Sponsored Horse Shows require all youth (ages 8-18) to wear a certified equestrian helmet with safety harness fastened in place in over fences classes, gymkhana events, activities and practice sessions.

Youth must be at least 8 years old by January 1 of the current year to participate.

SUMMIT COUNTY 4-H HORSE SHOW RULES

The 4-H Horse Show...

1. Will be governed by the 2009 Colorado 4-H Horse Show Rule Book.
2. Is only open to Summit County 4-H members in good standing.
3. Superintendent, Kathie M. Kralik, has the right to make any changes to the horse show schedule, at any time.
4. Superintendent will dismiss any participant/parent/leader who is showing poor sportsmanship, and/or is treating their horse in an unethical manner at any time with no class refunds.
5. Superintendent will dismiss any participant/parent/leader who is not abiding by the 4-H Code of Conduct at any time with no class refunds.
6. Additions or subtractions of classes must be done two classes before the said class.
7. Placings of entrants by the Judge are final!
8. All tie-breaks will be judged on how the exhibitor placed in the showmanship class, and on the quality of the exhibitor's 4-H Horse Record book and Community Service projects.
